


Micronutrient deficiency

- Vitamin B12, B6, Folate
- Sodium
- Vitamin D3
- Albumin

THE IRREVERSIBLE DEMENTIAS

 Alzheimers, frontotemporal are some of the irreversible dementias



FDG-PET images show reduced glucose metabolism in temporal and parietal regions in Alzheimer's disease and mild cognitive impairment.

THE REVERSIBLE DEMENTIAS

Reversible dementias

- B12 deficiency
- B6 deficiency
- Folate deficiency
- Thyroid and iron too

TREATMENT


- B12 500micrograms intramuscular thrice weekly for 2 weeks and then orally for 3 months
- Folate- 5mg orally as maintenance

HYPONATREMIA

- Non specific symptoms
- Generalised malaise
- Nausea, vomiting
- Reduced appetite
- Drowsiness

HYPONATREMIA- ASSESSMENT

- Hypervolemic- CCF, nephrotic syndrome
- Euvolemic- SIADH- urine osm > serum osm
- Hypovolemic- Dehydration, GE, Drugs



HYPONATREMIA- TREATMENT

- Dictum- NEVER increase sodium more than 8-10 units / 24 hours
- Hypertonic saline
- Salt replacement in diet
- Fluid restriction
- Aquaporin blockers

ALBUMIN

- Diagnostic and prognostic
- Sepsis
- Chronic debilitating conditions
- Post operative recovery
- Disease prognosis

ALBUMIN

• NEVER treat low Albumin with Albumin!

- Oncotic pressure
- Ideal to replace with amino acids

VITAMIN D

- Nutritional
- Skin turgor
- Indoor confinement

VITAMIN D DEFICIENCY


- Osteomalacia
- Osteoporosis
- ? Renal and cardiac functioning

VITAMIN D

- Intramuscular 6,00,000 units X 4
- Maintenance as oral for 6 months

TREATMENT OF NUTRITION DEFICIENCY

 Sodium correction and the risk of Central Pontine Myelinolysis






TREATMENT OF DEFICIENCY

Aspiration

Dictum - do not feed the patient orally if GCS<15




- Oral High
- RT Moderate
- PEG Low





- Medium term- 6-8 weeks
- Recovery
- 75- 100ml/hour, every alternate hour
- No feeds between 2200 and 0600
- To be fed whilst erect at 90 degrees



PEG

- Long term
- Advanced dementia, stroke,
- 100- 125mls/hour
- Again, no feeds between 2200 and 0600
- Position may be slightly reclined- 70-80 degrees

COMING BACK-

- Does treatment of nutrition deficiency
 - save lives
 - claim lives
